
Elowen Garden Village with over 300 new Bloor homes will form part of Halsnead Garden Village, one of the just fourteen garden villages in the UK. The development will consist of tree-lined streets, well-connected open spaces and wildlife corridors, which complement existing natural features to create a highly attractive and walkable neighbourhood, the perfect balance of urban living that remains close to nature.













Families moving to Elowen Garden Village will find a range of primary schools within walking distance, Catholic, C of E and Academy schools all achieving Good in their latest Ofsted Inspection. Just a short commute away you will find a selection of high schools and sixth form colleges including Carmel College with its excellent reputation.

There are lovely places to visit in the local area. If you fancy a family walk to a nice and peaceful location you can choose between Stadt Moer Country Park or Whiston Woods. Stadt Moor Park covers 220 acres of meadows, woodlands and pond habitats amongst a network of footpaths and includes visitors facilities whereas Whiston woods is a community woodland with trees, wildflowers, paths and wildlife waiting to be discovered.

Knowsley Safari Park is ideal for a great family day out. Take a tour of the 550 acres safari drive and get acquainted with over 700 wild animals from baboons to camels,

wildebeest to tigers, all from the comfort of your own car, on foot you can explore the Amur Tiger trail, get up close and personal with the giraffes, watch the sea lion show and meet the cheeky meerkats.

Croxteth Hall Country Park is at the heart of what was once a great country estate stretching hundreds of square miles and was the ancestral home of the Molyneux family, the Earls of Sefton. After the death of the last Earl it was given to the City of Liverpool. The estate has four main attractions - the historic hall, Croxteth Home Farm (which is still a working farm with livestock, that youngsters will love), the Victorian Walled Garden, and a 500 acre country park, well worth a visit!

Knowsley Leisure & Culture Park is just a 5 minute drive away featuring two swimming pools, a state of the art gym, indoor sports centre, squash courts and fitness studio.



If you prefer to travel by rail Prescot station offer frequent direct trains to Liverpool in under 25 mins, or you can be in Manchester city centre in less than 45 minutes if you take a train from Whiston Station. When it's time for International travel, Liverpool's John Lennon Airport is only a 15 minute drive / taxi ride away from home.











Everyday shops can be found in Whiston Village itself, including a very convenient Tesco Express. For your weekly shopping and a spot of retail therapy Prescot Retail Park is your answer with a Marks and Spencer Foodhall, Tesco Extra, Next and many more.

For a wider range of shops, culture and entertainment options, visit the popular city of Liverpool, only 9 miles away. With so many attractions it's hard to work out what to visit first! The stunning Albert Dock, a World Heritage waterfront, is a must-see, visit Tate Liverpool, the Merseyside Maritime Museum, hear The Beatles Story and experience the world famous Cavern Club. Liverpool One shopping district is perfect for a bit of retail therapy, packed full of designer names and high street stores, you can shop until you drop! All of these iconic land marks can be reached in under 25 mins!

St Helen's, Widnes and Warrington are also great towns with an array of shops, bars and restaurants, they can all be easily reached from Elowen Garden Village if you don't feel like venturing into the city!

If you prefer the peace and quiet of the sea, there are quite a few beaches to visit, Crosby being the closest, just a 30 minute drive way. You can walk along the beach, home to 'Another Place' the sculpture by Antony Gormley, or along the Coastal Path and take in views of the sea, the Wirral and North Wales. Slightly further up the coast is the National Trust Formby beach, famous for its spectacular sands surrounded by sweeping coastal pinewood.
