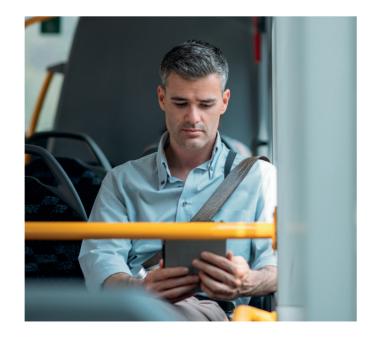

Catching the Bus



There is already an excellent bus network running past the site, seven days a week.

The locations of existing bus stops and routes are demonstrated on the Bus Map. The nearest bus stops are on Monahan Way, which are within a five-minute walk from Brize Meadow, the S2 and 233 buses can be taken from these stops, other services can be found within walking distance as shown on the Bus Map. As part of the measures to promote bus travel to / from the site, the S2 express service to Oxford has now been enhanced to run every 20 minutes from the previous half hourly frequency.

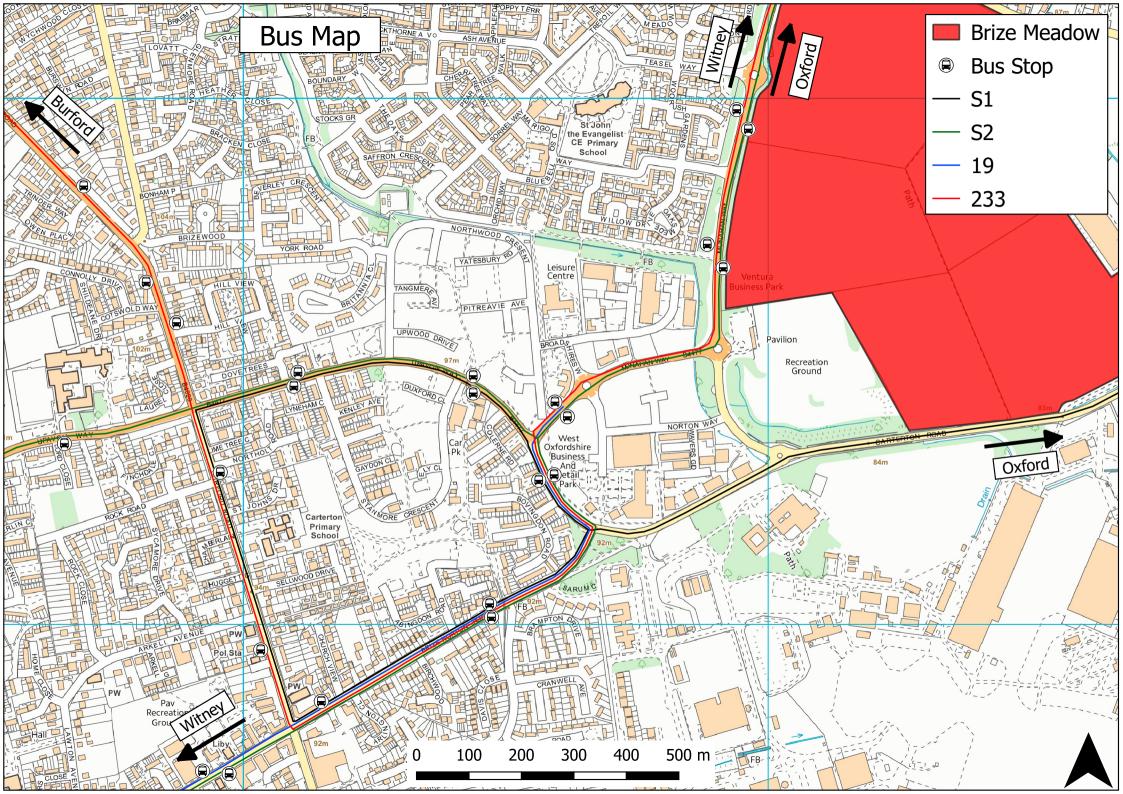

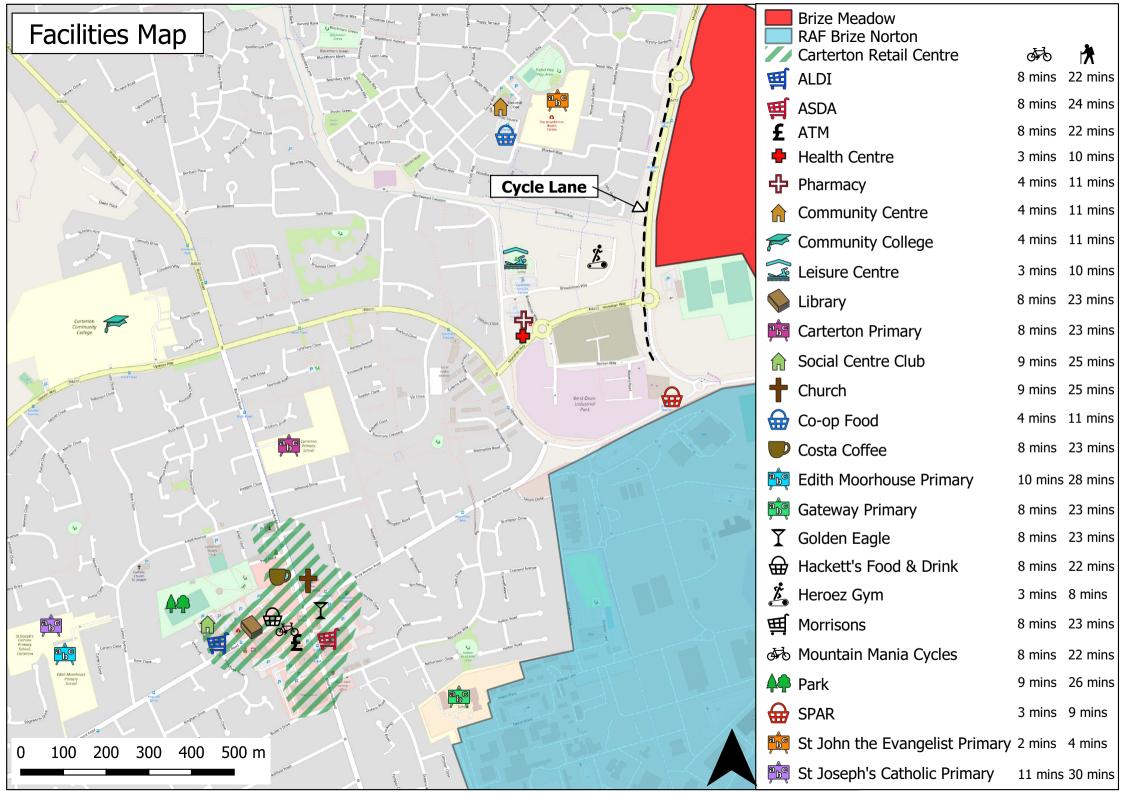

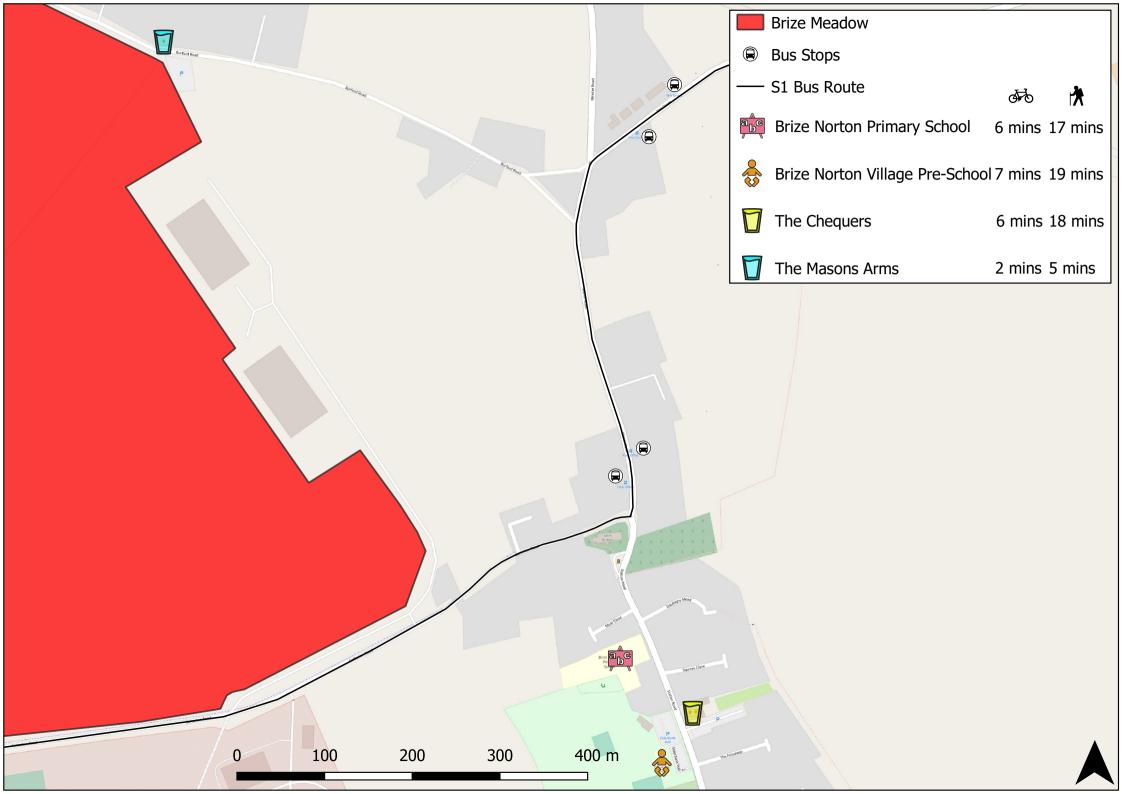
